The Township Clerk lead the Pledge of Allegiance, and confirmed that 8 electors/voters from the Township were present. A motion was made by Staci Early with a second by Don Johnston to accept the number of electors/voters present. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

The Township Clerk called for a motion for the nomination of a moderator. A motion was moved to nominate Kayla Knott as Moderator by Abbie Hakemian with a second from Don Johnston. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

The Township Clerk administered the Oath of Moderator to Kayla Knott.

Moderator Kayla Knott confirmed the Agenda & Notice of Meeting which was posted in 3 different locations. The Moderator also confirmed that the electors/voters all had copies of the Agenda and Notice of Meeting for their review.

The Minutes of the Annual Town Meeting held on April 9th, 2019 were reviewed. Don Johnston with a second from Rand Wilson moved for a motion to accept as read. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Moderator Kayla Knott presented the Supervisor's Annual Financial Statement and read the beginning, ending and total balances. Don Johnston with a second from Harry Perez moved for a motion to approve. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Don Johnston moved with a second from Abbie Hakemian for a Resolution for setting the time of the 2021 Annual Town Meeting to be held @ 6:01 pm on April 13th 2021. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.


There was no old business; no new business or public comments.
